If required, apply appropriate cover dressing to maintain a The choice of an additional cover dressing will depend moisture-balanced wound environment. upon the amount of exudate expected. Roll down lower of tube bandage over the non-adhering layer and cover dressing if being used. Then apply the top ring to form a double-layer tube dressing.

Carefully lift away the dressing and discard. To avoid trauma to the wound bed. **Frequency of Dressing Change** Will depend upon the amount of exudate. Adaptic Digit may be left in place for up to 7 days. **Expected Outcome** Contact layer does not adhere to wound.
