





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To Remove			
If primary dressing adheres to the wound bed then flush with	To avoid trauma to the wound bed.

Natural plant waxes may remain in the wound, this

Frequency of Dressing Change			
Change will depend upon the amount of exudate. Product is	Ensure sufficient amount of honey is maintained for full
