Indications	For wounds which have moderate to large/copious amount of exudate	
	May be used under compression wraps	
Precautions	May be used on wounds with S&S of infection when the infection is being treated.	
Contraindications	<ul><li>Do not use on full thickness burns</li><li>Do not use on lesions with active vasculitis</li></ul>

Frequency of Dressin		
Change the dressing when the exudate is present at the edge of the foam pad. Do not allow exudate to accumulate under the backing.		
Depending upon the amount of exudate, the dressing may be left in place for up to 7 days.
