Cleanse the wound and peri-wound skin with sterile normal saline or agency approved wound cleanser; dry the peri-wound skin.		Reduces wound debris and allows for adhesion of dressing or tape.
Do not apply any skin barrier under the dressing.		Skin barrier will prevent the transmission of exudate upwards into the superabsorbent layer.
To Apply		
Apply dressing to the wound (white side down) with at least 2- 4cm overlap on the peri-wound skin.		Facilitates absorption of exudate at the edges of the wound.
