| Application Directions | Measure tubular dressing against digit (finger or toe) to determine the length of dressing Cut dressing to size. Remove the insert from the rolled end of the dressing; discard insert. Insert digit into the rolled end and push finger into the dressing. Roll dressing onto the digit. Ensure dressing fits securely and not too tight on the digit. |
| Dressing Change | Change dressing when it becomes soiled or loose. |
